

The sculptures on the trail were created over a two year period by local sculptor Bill Welch. All of the sculptures are carved out of natural fallen timber from Eastham Country Park. Each sculpture represents an aspect of the wildlife and history of the park. Eventually, these works of art will decay, returning to the soil to become part of the woodland cycle again.
